### **Purpose**

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide funding for up to ten (10) scholarships for students enrolled at San Diego City, Mesa or Miramar College. The scholarship will provide up to two (2) years of support for each selected student (\$1000/year). The goal of the scholarship is to provide much needed financial aid for community college students enrolled in career technical programs that lead to jobs.

### **Scholarship Description**

The Mahatma Gandhi Scholarship is intended for financially needy students who are first in their family to go to college. The scholarship will cover tuition and books at San Diego City College, Mesa College or San Diego Miramar College for a two-year period in an amount of \$1,000 each year. Ten scholarships are available annually.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

- Students must complete an application for Financial Aid (FASFA), and be eligible for financial aid (demonstrated need)
- Students must be first in their family to attend college
- Students must write an essay on the importance of peace and non-violence in our community and the world (not to exceed one typewritten page)
- Students must be pursuing a career-technical program of study

### **Selection Criteria**

- A slate of finalists will be selected by the district scholarship committee
- Finalists will be required to participate in a short interview with members of San Diego Indian American Society to be conducted on campus
- San Diego Indian American Society will select final recipients
