CARES Act Stimulus

- Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund
- District Allocation \$13,739718
 - Requires that a <u>minimum</u> of 50% of the funds are to be used for direct aid to students
 - Miramar direct aid for students \$1,511,369
 - Encouraged to focus on student need
 - Balance of funding will be identified and allocated
 - Creation of a one-time Stimulus Taskforce to brainstorm Miramar needs
 - A portion of this balance may be used for direct aid to students
 - One year to use the allocation

- All areas being asked to review budgets and create scenarios for decreases
- 2020/2021 Enrollment Target
 - FTEF 502 (reduced by 18 from 19/20 actual)
 - FTES 7,526
 - SU20 FTEF 39.66 (as of 4/13 and reduced by 14.36 from 19/20 actual)
