Violators may be cited and/or vehicles towed at owner's expense. For information on towed vehicles call College Police (619) 388-6405.



CARES Act Emergency Grant


- Approximately \$1.5 million in direct aid to students
- Have been impacted by campus closure due to COVID-19
- Meet FAFSA eligibility
- SD Miramar is "campus of record"
- Currently enrolled in at least 6 units for Spring 2020
- \$350 for FT (12 units or more); \$300 for PT (6 11.9 units)
- We will disburse funds until exhausted (Summer/Fall)



California Budget Process Overview

- California Budget Status
 - Property Taxes are late
 - Corporate and Individual Tax revenue will be down
- SDCCD Budget Status
 - Multi-year budget shortfall
 - Impact of SCFF FTES = 70% and Performance = 30%
 - Unknown enrollment trends for 20-21

VPI Hopkins

Spring 2020

- Developing plans to complete "hard to convert" classes with campus access, observing social distancing and all established health protocols.
- All Grades due June 30, 2020.

Summer 2020

- Online offerings only.
- Managing enrollment with immediate focus on early summer short-term sections 6/3/20 6/30/20.
- Targeting productivity ratio of 15, which translates to an average class sizes of 30 students campus-wide.

Fall 2020 Schedule Development

- Scheduling primarily online delivery directive, and developing plans for exceptions (hard to convert classes), which will be offered on-campus, observing social-distancing and all established health protocols, via partially online approaches:
- Science Labs (it may be necessary to conduct the actual classes on line, with the labs on campus)
- Allied Health Clinical Labs (also perhaps in a partially online format)
- Career-Technical Labs (also perhaps in a partially online format)

Emergency Temporary DE Addendum due to State Chancellor's Office

- Summer 2020 due May 20; Fall 2020 due July.
- Faculty must identify courses that need to be included in the Emergency Temporary DE Addendums.
- Plan for obtaining local curriculum approval for all courses included in the submitted addendums by December 2020.
- Plan for ongoing professional development for faculty and staff for converting to online instruction.

Converting to Online Opportunities

- Watch for Summer 2020 *DE* and *Establishing Safe Classrooms* professional development opportunities.
- Work with your deans to secure supplies, equipment, and software for your Fall 2020 online classes now.
