



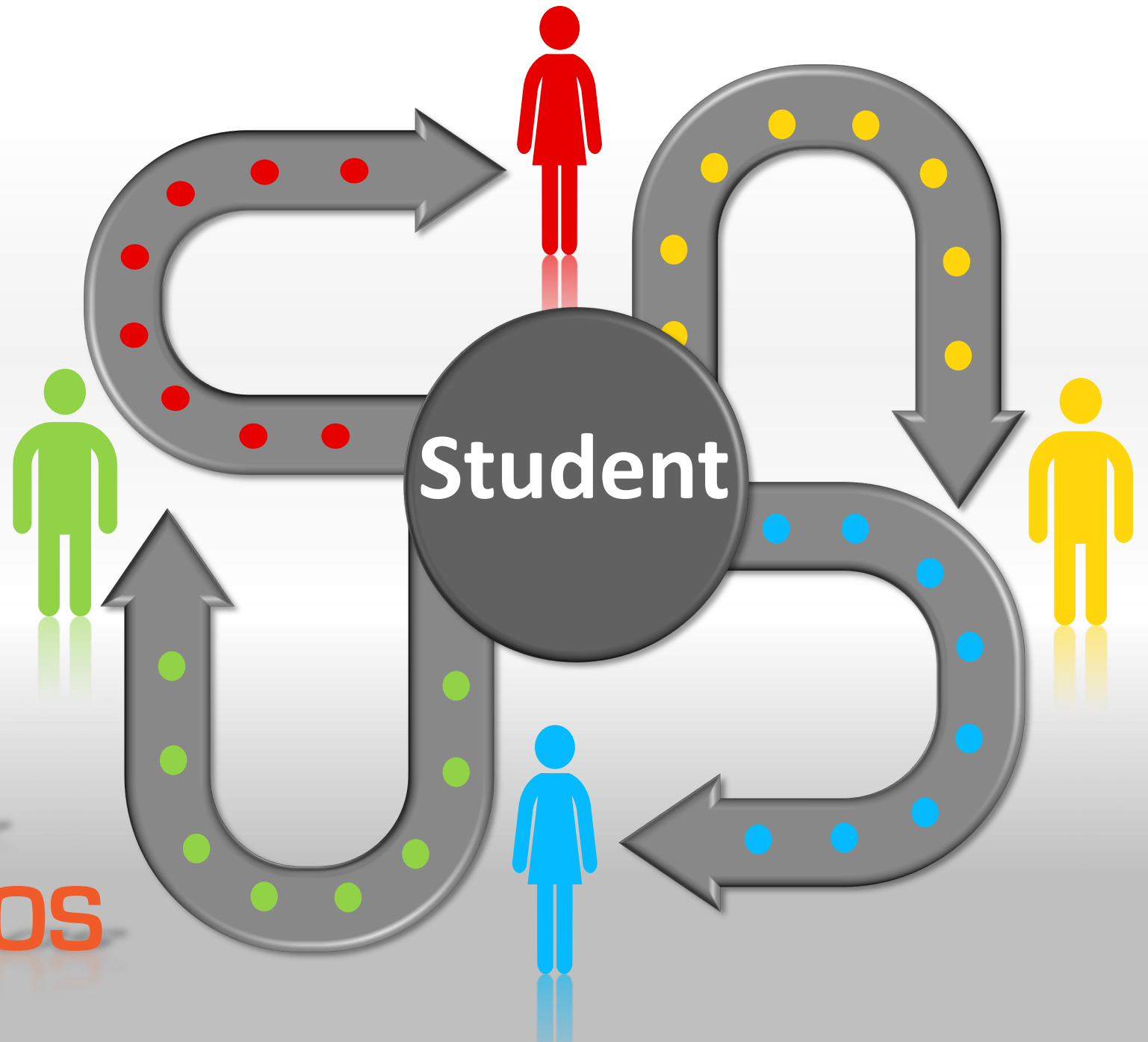




GET OFF THE PATH
