SABBATICAL LEAVES

Sabbatical leave opportunities are detailed in Article 18 of the AFT Guild College Faculty Agreement and Article 9 of the Adult Educators Agreement. (www.aftguild.org)

- 1. The number of sabbaticals for 2021-2022 has not been announced yet. Miramar had 4 slots in 2020-2021.
- 2. Full-time tenured faculty may apply for a sabbatical after six (6) consecutive years of service. As a pilot program beginning in January 2020, adjunct faculty may apply for a sabbatical leave after six consecutive years of service.
- 3. Sabbaticals can be used for:

*Study *Retraining *Teaching, learning and appropriate instructional and student services *Research

4. Important dates for 2021-2022 sabbatical leave applicants:

Monday, February 1, 2021 – Application due to appropriate Department Chair/Supervisor. *Faculty are advised to follow up on their applications to make sure these get to the dean by the deadline.*

Friday, February 5, 2021 – completed sabbatical leave request due to school dean or appropriate manager. *Faculty members applying for a research sabbatical must schedule a meeting with the President to discuss their sabbatical and the methodologies being used. This needs to be done prior to the submission of the sabbatical to the PAC.*

Friday, February 19, 2021 – Deans/Manager forward sabbatical leave requests to Chair of Professional Advancement Committee (PAC), Roger Olson.

Friday, March 12, 2021 – PAC forwards their recommendations to Vice President.

Wednesday, April 7, 2021 – Vice President reviews, signs, and sends recommendations to College President.

Wednesday, April 21, 2021 – College President notifies applicants regarding their application.

Note: Faculty are advised to follow up on their applications to make sure the applications are moved along in a timely manner.

Note: If any date listed falls on a weekend or holiday, the new date shall be the first working day following the listed date.
