Selection Criteria

- Must be an ASG cardholder at San Diego Miramar College for the SPRING 2021 Semester.
- At least holding six units and actively enrolled in San Diego Miramar College.

The categories are:

• General Leadership (12 scholarships)

2.5 GPA requirement, (1) Letter of recommendation required <u>Essay Prompt/Criteria:</u> 1-2 pages, double-spaced, typed in 12-point font Describe your involvement in the community, or as a student leader at San Diego Miramar College. How have your contributions improved your community/school?

• ASG Members & Chartered Club Officers (5 scholarships)

Must be a voting member or active officer of a chartered club, 2.5 GPA requirement, actively enrolled in 9 units within the SDCCD, (1) Letter of recommendation required <u>Essay Prompt/Criteria</u>: 1-2 pages, double-spaced, typed in 12-point font *How has your experience as a member of ASG or chartered club strengthened your leadership skills? Describe how you have applied those leadership skills.*

Incoming Student (2 scholarships)

(1) Letter of recommendation required, no previous enrollment with the SDCCD <u>Essay Prompt/Criteria</u>: 1-2 pages, double-spaced, typed in 12-point font Describe your leadership involvement in either your community or as a student leader at San Diego Miramar College/previous institution. How have your contributions improved your community/school?

• Working Student (6 scholarships)

(Minimum ten hours) Be a part-time worker with proof (*pay stub, ticket, etc.) 2.5 GPA requirement

<u>Essay Prompt/Criteria:</u> 1-2 pages, double-spaced, typed in 12-point font Describe how you have shown a leadership role in your work environment. How have you incorporated those leadership skills into your role as a student?

• Need Based (10 scholarships)

California College Promise Grant and/or Part of EOPS, 2.5 GPA requirement <u>Essay Prompt/Criteria</u>: 1-2 pages, double-spaced, typed in 12-point font *If awarded a scholarship, describe how that would help you achieve your goals of becoming a leader at San Diego Miramar College?*

• Academic Achievement (5 scholarships)

3.25 GPA, full-time student (12 units minimum), (1) Letter of recommendation required <u>Essay Prompt/Criteria</u>: 1-2 pages, double-spaced, typed in 12-point font Describe how you have shown high academic achievement, as a full-time student at San Diego Miramar College. How have you balanced your studies with leadership role at Miramar College?
