1	Spring 2021 tutoring support D. Tran reviewed spring schedule and potential methods (live vs. drop in). Currently piloting by appointment tutoring with a personal growth and potentially expanding for special population groups such as EOPS and Promise. SI leaders will work from 2/1-5/27, walk-in tutoring will be 2/8-5/27, embedded tutors will be available in select CTE courses for the Spring of 2021 and we will continue our collaboration with College2Careers in CBTE and Paralegal courses. N.Julian submitted a CARES Funding Request to continue NetTutor in the Spring of 2021, D.Tran reviewed NetTutor usage data to support the extension. M.McMahon shared NetTutor and the funding request was discussed and supported at CEC. F.Bereaud and D.Tran discussed tutoring hours and subjects covered considering budget constraints. Currently tutoring will not be available Summer 2021. N.Julian reviewed potential cost saving measures during the Spring in order to save funds for Summer understanding that the fiscal budget closes June 30, 2020. 

NetTutor Student Traffic


February 1, 2021 to February 4, 2021 (M-Th)





February 5, 2021 (F, when ASC is closed)




