Community College Aerospace Scholars (NCAS) onsite experience Feb. 13-15. Pratt was one of 171 community college students from across the United States to take part in the NCAS onsite experience. The five-week online activity culminated with a four-day on-site event at a NASA Center and offered students the opportunity to interact with NASA engineers and others as they learn more about careers in science and engineering. While at NASA, students form teams and establish fictional companies interested in Mars exploration. Each team is responsible for developing and testing a prototype rover, forming a company infrastructure, managing a budget, and developing communications and outreach. The onsite experience at NASA includes briefings by NASA subject matter experts, information on how to apply for internships and a tour of NASA's unique facilities.

Science Festival


